



Safety and Sanitation Activity Protocol for games for LFA teams

Before Activity Begins

- a. Attendance Tracker & Screener (we suggest they are the same person) arrive at park first and set up at the ingress point. Max 20 minutes before scheduled time.
 - i. Screen every person who arrives and record their information on the Attendance Tracker Sheet.
 - ii. Each team is responsible for their own tracking. This includes any Role Holders. No spectators are allowed. Find out which team they belong to and that team is to screen and track them.
 - iii. The Home team is responsible for screening and tracking the umpires.
- b. Sanitation Champion checks in with Screener and Attendance Tracker. Then heads to equipment bin with Sanitation Bucket to gather rest of disinfecting supplies.
 - i. Disinfect any high-touch surfaces, including posts, bases, equipment bin.
 - ii. Hang hand sanitizer bottle on outside of backstop for spectators.
 - iii. Make sure team hand sanitizer is in a visible spot for easy use.
- c. In-Charge Person (Injury Attendant) makes sure they have gloves and masks available in case of injury.
- d. Players arrive at park ready to go, with cleats on, no more than 15 minutes before scheduled start of activity. Ie. If game warm-up is to start at 5:30pm, players can arrive at 5:15pm.

During Activity

- e. Attendance Tracker & Screener continues to monitor for new participants. There can be no more than 50 people in attendance.
- f. Sanitation Champion continues to make sure participants are using hand sanitizer on a regular basis.
- g. Sanitation Champion makes sure bats are only picked up by the barrel.

- h. Sanitation Champion make sure balls are sanitized and rotated out frequently.
- i. Distancing Monitor makes sure participants and spectators are maintaining their distance from each other.

After Activity

- j. Attendance Tracker takes a photo of Attendance sheet for the activity and emails it to the LFA Attendance Coordinator at lfafields@gmail.com . For in-club games, each team is responsible for submitting their tracking sheet. For inter-club games, the LFA attendance tracker is only responsible for submitting their own tracking sheet. Visiting team will submit to their association.
- i. Sanitation Champion uses diamond disinfectant to clean high touch surfaces, including team equipment. Gathers rest of sanitation supplies and places into Sanitation Bucket.
 - i. Sanitation Champion emails operationslfa@gmail.com if any of the supplies are running low.
- j. Everyone is to be out of the park 15 minutes after the scheduled end of the activity.
